Family Involvement

- 1. Clients and Families are informed of how to access information during their orientation and on an on-going basis through the provision of the ASC information package, and Service Orientation/ Renewal Package where applicable.
- 2. Facilitation of Client and Family involvement may occur through, but is not limited to:
 - Supporting people to connect with their families
 - Opportunities for family to participate with the day to day service delivery
 - Service orientation/renewal processes
 - Person centered planning processes
 - Regular updates (verbal or written as applicable)
 - Client and family meetings (as applicable)
 - Addressing concerns process (as per Addressing Concerns Policy and Procedure)
- Both individual choice and family involvement are respected within ASC. If required, ASC will facilitate between clients and their families to help them reach mutual agreements.
- 4. ASC will provide opportunity for client and family meetings at least annually in 24 hour homes that are required to meet Accommodation and Licensing Standards.
 - These meetings will be open to all clients who reside in the home, and their families
 - Invitation to attend the meeting will be made a minimum of two weeks prior to the meeting date, and this invitation will be posted in the home
 - The ASC Agency Representative at the meetings will be the Area Coordinator
 - The meeting will be documented on a Client Family Meeting Form

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
