ASC will have a Behaviour Review Committee to ensure accountability and consistency with the management of situations or behaviours of concern.

Policy Statement

The Behaviour Review Committee will include a "Qualified Person", defined as an employee with at least two years relevant training and three years practical experience in behavior management strategies; and a minimum of two other members which may include but not be limited to:

- An External Person
- A Program Manager
- The Executive Director
- An Area Coordinator/designate as applicable

ASC Behaviour Review Committee

The Behaviour Review Committee will meet on a regular basis, and as needed, to ensure the timely review and management of situations and behaviours of concern.

The Behaviour Review Committee is responsible to:

- Provide leadership through functional and risk assessment processes
- Meet with a minimum of 3 members not involved in the writing of the Planned Procedures being presented for approval
- Review the information presented
- Review the appropriateness of specific interventions and/or recommend alternatives as per client needs and agency resources
- Provide or deny authorization for the use of Planned Procedures
- Set the review date as required
- Maintain minutes pertaining to the discussions on the client's main file
- Maintain a file for any information reviewed by the committee that does not pertain to a client. This information may be used for ASC policy and procedure review
- Ensure all applicable employees are trained to Behaviour Support Plans
- Compile, graph, and monitor the trends in behaviour data
