Dress Code

Purpose To present a neat, clean and professional appearance that will

promote a positive image with co-workers and the public, as well as

standards for safety.

Policy Statement Employees of the Olds Bottle Depot will be required to follow a dress code and wear specific personal protective clothing to meet Health

and Safety Standards.

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Dress Code

Clothing:

- 1. Supplied gloves must be worn at all times when handling products.
- 2. Jeans are to be worn. Jeans should be:
 - Comfortable to work in.
 - Relaxed fit or straight leg, but not extremely tight or too baggy.
 - Plain blue or black.
- 3. Shorts or Sweat Pants will not be worn.
- 4. Steel toe shoes or boots are to be purchased and worn for the first day of work.
- 5. Bottle Depot shirts will be worn by all employees.
- 6. Bottle Depot jackets will be worn when needed.
- 7. Clean aprons will be worn in the Depot each day.
- 8. Bottle Depot hats may be worn.

Employer Responsibilities:

- 1. Bottle Depot Management will purchase and supply gloves, aprons, shirts, jackets and hats.
- 2. Employees will receive up to a \$100.00 refund upon completion of the successful probationary period, and annually thereafter to offset the cost of footwear.

Employee Responsibilities:

- 1. Employees are responsible to keep their work clothes clean, in good repair and to take their laundry home (including aprons).
- 2. Employees are not to wear their aprons after they leave the Depot.
- 3. Depot jackets can be worn when needed, but they must be left at the Depot.
- 4. Employees will have the opportunity to purchase additional items at a discounted price.

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
