- Experience and education related to Disability Services
- A clear Criminal Record Check

- Effective oral and written communication skills

### **ASC Offers:**

Compensation consists of the following depending on experience:

\$18.00 - \$19.00 per hour base rate for weekdays.

\$21.00 - \$22.00 per hour base rate for weekends; sleep shifts are paid at minimum wage.

100% Employer contribution for Employee and Family Assistance Program for Fulltime, Part time, and Casual staff begins the day you start.
