Casual hours for Awake Nights

Celebrating 50 years, Accredited Supports to the Community (ASC) *is currently recruiting a casual Community Support Worker to work in 24-hour Residential Services, supporting adults with developmental disabilities. Shifts available include vacation and sick coverage for the awake night shift (10pm - 8am).*

This position will rotate between 3 barrier free homes in the communities of Olds and Didsbury. The Community Support worker will work with individuals who require lifting, transfers, and support in all aspects of daily living. The emphasis in this awake night position is on providing direct personal care; household cleaning to required standards and cooking/meal preparation.

Responsibilities:

- Ensure individuals have adequate and necessary supports while focusing on skill development and independence
- Flexible and adaptable to support the ongoing needs of individuals
- Ability to adapt to new and changing regulations
- Medication administration and personal care support to individuals
- Accurate and respectful documentation
- General household duties, including cleaning to specified standards and preparing nutritional meals

- Grade 12 or General Equivalency Diploma
- Flexibility with work schedule - ability to work with short notice
- A current driver's license and reliable vehicle
- A clear Vulnerable Sector Criminal Records Check
- Effective problem-solving skills
- Strong oral and written communication skills
