Hours of work are part time and based on the needs of the individual(s) ASC supports, therefore, shifts may vary. The successful candidate will have the flexibility to work a combination of days, evenings, and weekends.

Services are individualized and Senior Supports are inclusive in the following responsibilities:

- Provide services to Seniors in their homes which can include driving and accompanying to appointments, errands, shopping and outings, meal preparation, light housekeeping, and/or providing companionship
- Emotional support to facilitate health coping habits and social engagement
- Assist with mobility devices
- Ability to ensure the person's safety and comfort, which includes promoting the independence and mental well-being of the person in a respectful and compassionate manner
- Complete records and documentation accurately and thoroughly

Education and Requirements:

- Grade 12, GED, or proven experience
- We provide internal mandatory professional development for those who have the willingness and desire to enter support services
- A minimum 1 year working with seniors will be considered an asset
- Human Services and/or medical training is an asset
- Standard First Aid/CPR Certification or willing to obtain in first 3 months of employment
- A reliable vehicle, class 5 driver's license is a requirement to transport clients within the community and to appointments
- Proof of vehicle insurance showing \$2 million liability coverage
- Vulnerable Sector Criminal Records Check issued by the RCMP or City Police
- Strong oral and written communication skills to learn proficient and respectful documentation and computer literacy
- Two managerial/supervisor references from your most current employment
- Strong communications skills both verbal and written
- Ability to maintain confidentiality and professional boundaries
- Positive and respectful relationship building skills
